My name is Laurin and I am 9 years old. At the age of three, I had a severe case of meningococcal septicaemia. I lost both lower legs and parts of my hands. I'm full of energy and love being active - snowboarding, biking, bouldering or floorball. These activities are important to me. They allow me to spend time with my friends and have fun. I'm very creative at finding solutions, but here and there it's just easier with an aid. For hockey, I needed a solution that would allow me to move the stick back and forth quickly. At the same time, I want to be able to put such an aid on and take it off independently.

## HOW I NOW EXPERIENCE THE ACTIVITIES DIFFERENTLY

It is important to me that the aids are easy to use and that I can use them independently. The Lynk System gives me a lot of independence. It's comfortable and I can use it in many different ways.
