



MY SITUATION AND NEED

My name is Wanda, I am 33 years old and was born with dysmelia on my right forearm. I didn't use a prosthesis for a long time. As a result, I overused my left hand, which led to problems in my joints. But shortly after I started using a myoelectric prosthesis, I developed chronic skin eczema. This forced me to look for alternatives. And that's how I discovered the Explorer System - I use it for sports, especially cycling. With the breathable Explorer Socket, I sweat less on my arm and my eczema problem got much better.

HOW I NOW EXPERIENCE THE ACTIVITY DIFFERENTLY

For me, it is important that my skin is not exposed to too much strain as I suffer from a chronically inflamed area of skin. My prosthesis is breathable and lightweight, so the skin on my arm is now less stressed and can breathe. This means I no longer have to worry about pain. It also provides me with support for sporting activities on my bike, ensures good posture and takes the strain off my left hand.

MY EXPERIENCE AFTER 6 MONTHS OF USE

My skin has healed up a lot because of the breathable socket design. I can now enjoy long bike rides without discomfort.
